What can C.A.M.P. do for you?

Having an amputation is a life altering event. Amputees have common needs that are not always met by the people and organizations involved in their care.

The staff at **CAMPStrong** have teamed with local experts on prosthetics and orthotics to create a comprehensive program to follow you from surgery to home and beyond. Our team will assist you every step of the way, because we believe no one should have to struggle to navigate the health care system alone.

Comprehensive Rehabilitation

Our experienced rehab department is trained to work with amputees using exercises specific to your needs following amputation. State-of-the-art equipment such as the Jintronix virtual reality system, and the Biodex balance system can help with gait and balance retraining. In addition to exercises, we use modalities such as the Chattanooga Electrical Stimulation and Ultra Sound machines, and the Chattanooga Diathermy machines. These modalities assist with wound healing, pain control, edema reduction and neuro re-education.

Our occupational therapists will focus on activities of daily living to include bathing, dressing and toileting, plus kitchen and home management.

Holistic Team Approach

Advanced Nursing Care - Our Team of licensed nurses and nursing assistants are here for you around the clock to provide post-operative wound care, pain management, medication management and any other assistance you require for your recovery.

Nutrition - Our full-time registered dietitian will assist in managing your nutritional needs to optimize wound healing and manage edema, diabetes and other medical conditions.

Mental Health Services - You may be experiencing depression, anxiety, and/or other stressors following amputation. Our team of consulting psychologists and mental health professionals are available for you or your loved ones to talk with.

Social Services - Our full-time social service staff will assist you with facilitating discharge planning and coordination of care and services for your return home. In addition, support groups are held on-site weekly by our licensed social workers.

Prosthetics - Together, we will work with a prosthetist to coordinate your care from per-operative planning, to initial temporary prosthetics, to a final product and adjustments along the way.
